What is the Charter and why are we asking for feedback?

The School Charter includes the strategic plan that the Board of Trustees and staff work towards when setting each year's annual goals. It captures the community's beliefs and aspirations. It outlines the school's mission statement, vision, values and strategic goals, and is designed to exist over a 3 to 5 year period. It is a collaborative document, developed together with the school community: parents, staff, students, and other key stakeholders, and is reviewed on a regular basis to ensure it remains current, and continues to meet the needs and goals of the school community.

Given how much the school has grown over the last few years, we are really keen to undertake a thorough review of the Charter to ensure it is still meeting our community's beliefs and aspirations, and this is why we are asking for input from you now. The Board looks forward to hearing your thoughts and feedback!

Members of the Board will be also be available in the staff room or in classrooms during the Student-Led Workshops to answer any questions you may have, or just for you to come and say 'Hello'.

Where: In your child's classroom

These workshops are intended to be a time for parents to find out more about their child's learning. It is your child's 'special time', a time when they do the talking; and for parents to listen, enjoy, encourage and ask questions. It is your child's opportunity to tell you about their learning without having to share you with others.

We have found that the Student-Led Workshops are most successful when children have their parents' complete attention - therefore we ask that siblings do not attend the Student-Led Workshops. After-school care is helping to provide supervision for school-age siblings. You will find them in R13, past the flying fox and climbing wall. We are not able to care for pre-school children and it would be appreciated if you could make alternative arrangements for the care of younger children for the duration of your child's Student-Led Workshop (about 30-45 minutes). If you are using after-school care for supervision of siblings please sign them in on the special register with a supervisor from About Kidz.
