## Emergency Food Packs Reminder

Please ensure all children have their emergency packs for 2019 at school as soon as possible. We have found that if these items are packed into a plastic ice-cream container, storage problems are greatly reduced.

**Please remember to NAME each child's pack. To be prepared for an emergency, we require ALL children to bring to school the following items:**

- 6-10 (wrapped) barley sugar lollies
- 1 plastic spoon
- 2 large plastic bags
