**School Values**

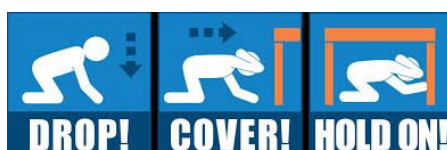





## School Photos are coming soon!

Next week we warmly welcome officers from ERO who are working with us for the week. The Education Review Office (ERO) is the New Zealand government department that evaluates and reports on the education and care of students in schools and early childhood services. An ERO review looks at how a school reaches positive learning outcomes - knowledge, skills, attitude and habits - for all children and young people. They're interested in what's working well and where improvements can be made. Schools are reviewed on average once every three years.
